**Product Type** Lounge Chair

In a fifties' Pirelli advertisement the Fiorenza armchair, designed by Franco Albini in 1952, was used as an image of foam rubber's potential, which fits like a glove and at that time was the most technologically advanced material used in upholstered furniture.

**STRUCTURE:** Solid fir wood.

**SPRINGING:** Elastic straps.

**SEAT UPHOLSTERY:** Shaped polyurethane with differentiated density / polyester slip cover.

**BACKREST AND ARMRESTS UPHOLSTERY:** Shaped polyurethane with differentiated density / polyester slip cover.

**BASE:** Beech wood, walnut stained or black lacquered.

**COVER :** Fabric or leather. Not removable cover.
