### Product Type Dining Chair

Boasting a shell crafted from 100% recycled plastic, Rely is a chair with environmentally-friendly credentials. The shell is available in a range of contemporary colours, while made-to-order upholstery for the shell is available in a variety of fabrics. Its base comes as fixed or swivel.

Material

Polypropylene, glass fiber, foam, upholstery, polished or powder coated aluminium.

### Production process

Shell made from 100% recycled polypropylene with 15% fiber glass. Upholstered seats are made with a veneer plate with 30mm foam. The swivel base is made from extruded aluminium, which is polished or powder coated. Swivel base for HW12 and swivel base w. return for HW17.

### Materials

Shell made from 100% recycled polypropylene with fiber glass, HR foam seat covered with fabric or leather upholstery, aluminium swivel base.

### Base finishes

Polished aluminium, Bronzed, Black

### Gliders

Plastic gliders installed as standard. Felt gliders available upon request.

### Shell colours

Black, White, Red Brown, Light Blue, Beige Sand, Stone Grey

### Seat upholstery

Seat upholstery available in all fabrics, leathers and COM

Fabric usage: 70x70cm (0.49 meter).

Leather usage: 100x100cm (1 square meter).

COM must be approved by &Tradition to ensure suitability for upholstery.
